All 3 courses will be offered! The classes will be hosted in Operations Center (Wi-Fi is available).

Computing in the Information Age Core Word, Excel & PowerPoint (CSC 100)

This course will prepare you to use computers and technology in attaining solutions to issues you face in the information society of today. You'll be guided through the latest developments in computer concepts, technology, and emerging issues. Course includes presentation and hands-on practice activities that support the concepts presented. Internet applications are practiced. You'll use a software suite which includes word processing, spreadsheet, database, and presentation software.

(CSC 105) / This course is designed to teach you the core skills in MS Word, MS Excel, and MS PowerPoint, which are MS Office Applications. Topics will prepare you to take the MOS (Microsoft Specialist) certification test upon completion. Familiarity with Windows including file management is highly recommended before taking this course.

Foundations in Advanced Manufacturing (ADM 100/200)

One of FLCC's Career Pathway Programs, you will learn core industry, safety, and quality assurance knowledge and skills used in the most in-demand advanced manufacturing occupations today. You'll learn from experts in the field, practice using VR and hands-on techniques and meet local employers seeking candidates who want more than just a job, who want a career for life. Graduates can take the nationally recognized CPT tests in safety and quality.
