COMMITTEE REPORTS:

<u>Audit</u>: MacMillan presented the Board Members with draft copies of the completed audits. MacMillan noted that once Mitchell has had time to review them she will prepare a final copy. Discussion was held.

Buildings and Grounds: Hall reported that the sidewalk in front of the Town Hall is cracked and shifted. Hall is concerned that someone will trip and fall on it. Discussion was held. Bernard reported that he will send two of the guys down from the Highway Department to take a look at it tomorrow. Bernard reported they will make a temporary repair of the sidewalk to make it safe for residents. Hall reported that he was unable to reach anyone from ViComp in regards to purchasing the Town's Artwork for \$150.00. Hall reported that he did contact Terry Baird who worked for ViComp and Terry reported that he believes that he has the original artwork for the Town. Hall reported that Baird will work with the Town if future artwork is needed. Discussion was held.

HIGHWAY: Nothing to report

IT/COMPUTER: Nothing to report.

INSURANCE: Nothing to report.

PARKS and RECREATION: Nothing to report.

WATER/SEWER VILLAGE OF BLOOMFIELD: MacMillan handed the floor over to Hawkins due to the fact that he attended the Committee Meeting last week. Hawkins reported that everyone involved in the Water Replacement Project attended the meeting except for the Contractor himself. Hawkins reported that everything appeared to be within the budget. Hawkins reported that the Whalen Road Project is still up in the air. MacMillan asked Hawkins if there was discussion regarding State Route 444? MacMillan reported that when she came into the Meeting Room that discussions by both himself and his son Todd were being held. Hawkins reported that yes, discussion was being held because Route 444 never got done even though there was a Resolution Passed to have the Water Installed. Hawkins reported that yes he brought it up to everyone at the meeting. Discussion was held. MacMillan reported that the Water District no longer exists due to the fact that the petition was never completely signed. Hawkins reported that the petition disappeared but one was filed for the whole distance. Hawkins reported that there was another petition for 3 people on the other end. Hawkins reported that when the second petition was done that "the original petition disappeared". Discussion was held. MacMillan told Hawkins that if he wanted to start another petition and get everyone to sign it to get water on Route 444 he could and the Town would start the project all over again. Hawkins replied "no", and that he started this process 40 years ago with Bill Teale and that's why he got into it to see how it worked. Hawkins reported that it was listed on a Resolution and that "District" was still listed on the Water Maps as of 2013. Discussion was held. Conklin reported that Dodie dissolved that Water District. Hawkins reported that Dodie never did that although she wanted to. Hawkins reported that they raised his taxes and that they paid for the Engineering Cost out of their taxes. Hawkins reported that everything was done. Discussion was held. Hawkins reported that they filed 2 petitions so that if one didn't work the other one would. Hawkins reported that one of them got "tossed out" or "set aside" when Dodie was here. Discussion was held. MacMillan reported that when Dianne Crowley was here that they got a proposed cost of the project and that everyone had to re-sign a new petition acknowledging the cost to them and that not everyone would sign it resulting in the Water District being abolished. Hawkins reported that was for the whole thing. Hawkins reported that Glenn Thornton did engineering resulting in the fact that you couldn't go over the hill because of the hydraulics of the water. Hawkins reported that you would have to put a pumping station on there and "that drove the price right out of sight", and that's why they couldn't do it. Discussion was held. Hawkins reported that basically the line runs right in front of his son's property and that they could run a service there under the road/ditch and hook him up. Hawkins reported then he himself is just another couple of hundred feet up the road. Hawkins claims that he has been in a Water District since 2000. Discussion was held. Conklin

asked if you could add people to a Water District? Hall reported that we do not have "A Town Wide Water District". MacMillan reported that they would have to be within the "Water District Boundaries". Discussion was held. Hall reported that if somebody outside the Water District wants to add on to the water they can't because the Town doesn't have a Town Wide Water District and it's considered an Out of District User and by law it has to go thru the whole process of Bonding and such to extend the Water District. Conklin said "so in other words it has to become a "New District then". Hall replied "yes, that's right". Discussion was held. Hawkins reported that if a "New Water District" was created it would only include himself, his son and a rental property (in which Hawkins owns). Discussion was held. Hall pointed out that proposed extension #7 was "shot down meaning that it's done". Hawkins argued that he has been in Water District 2 extension #4 since 2000. Extensive Discussion Ensued. MacMillan reported that someone will go through all the Resolutions that pertain to Water District 2 Extensions #4 and #7 for the history and to see if it was rescinded.

COMMUNICATIONS: Gochenaur reported that she has received acknowledgement of receipt of Resolution 2015-039 which is calling upon the Governor of New York and the New York State Legislature to allow additional state funding and resources for local transportation from Brian M. Kolb, State Assembly Minority Leader. Gochenaur reported that she has received a request from Linda Morotini requesting the use of Elton Park for St. Peter's Church Antique Show to be held on July 9, 2016. The Board agreed to the request. MacMillan reported that she received and e-mail from Dr. Patrick J. Keen, the Orchard Park Town Supervisor, in regards to a grass-roots initiative throughout New York State involving Town and Village Board Members relating to the current Tax Cap. MacMillan provided the Board with the letter that they are asking to be signed. Discussion was held. Conklin, Fessner, and MacMillan agreed the letter should be signed, while Hawkins disagreed. MacMillan will sign the letter provided in the e-mail and return it back to the Orchard Park Town Supervisor. MacMillan reported that the AWA has expressed interest in buying a piece of Veterans Park. MacMillan reported that after speaking to Dan Bryson about the sale of "Parkland" that it can only be accomplished with Legislative Approval. Discussion was held. MacMillan reported that she attended a meeting in regards to the Shared Court Facility and that they are also looking at Veterans Park as a possible location. Discussion was held.
